



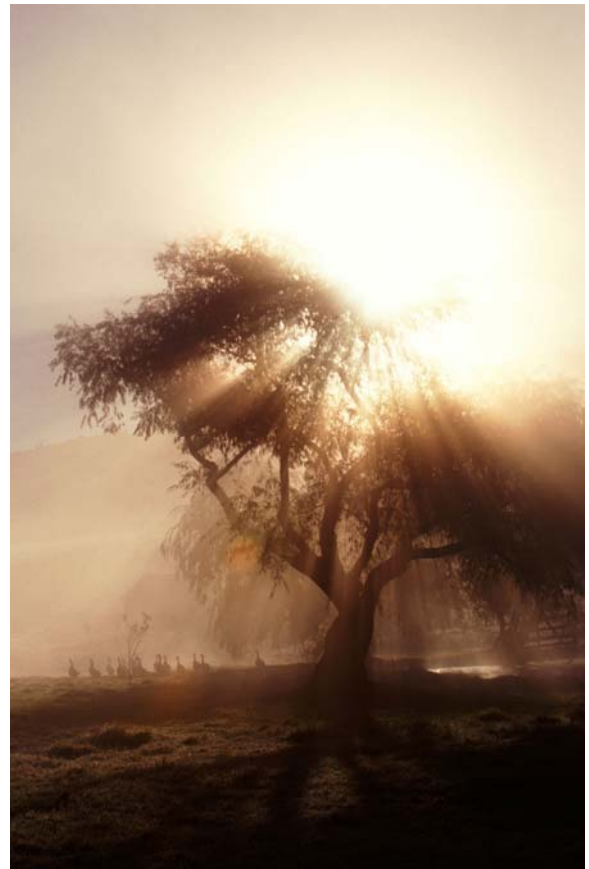
8th Annual Spirituality and Health Conference
